## NOTES

1. This application form is in respect of premises to be used as an Hotel or Boarding House, Licensed Premises, Entertainment including one off events
2. The completed form should be returned to the Secretary of the Department of Home Affairs, Homefield, 88 Woodbourne Road, Douglas. Telephone Douglas 623355.
3. An inspection of your premises will be made in due course by an Officer of the Fire Service and written requirements may be issued to you under the Act. After a final inspection of the work has been carried out and subject to the work being satisfactory, a Fire Certificate will be issued.
4. **If any work required has not been carried out or has not been completed satisfactorily within the time allowed and a Fire Certificate is refused, then no further application will be accepted until the work has been completed to the satisfaction of the Fire Authority.**
5. If you wish to carry out any building or renovation work of any nature before inspection, please consult with a Fire Prevention Officer prior to carrying out the work. This will ensure that the work does not conflict with the requirements of the Fire Precautions Act 1975.
6. If, following an inspection of the premises, the Fire Authority is satisfied that the risk to persons in case of fire is so serious that, until steps have been taken to reduce the risk to a reasonable level, the use of the premises ought to be prohibited or restricted, the Authority may by order prohibit or restrict, to the extent appropriate in the circumstances of the case, the use of the premises until such steps have been taken as are necessary to reduce the risk to a reasonable level.
